

- 1 A passenger vessel in international traffic shall pay the following passenger fee per each arriving and departing passenger: **1.00 EUR**

2 GENERAL TERMS

- 2.1. If the passenger vessel stays at the Port for accommodation purposes, 50 per cent of the fee specified under item 1 is charged per each passenger (resident) per each commencing day.
- 2.2 The fee is not charged for
- children under the age of 12
 - passengers of cruise vessels in non-regular liner traffic when the passengers, having arrived from abroad, continue their voyage on the same sailing to another port abroad
 - persons who are on board the vessel inspecting or supervising the functioning of its equipment at the order of authorities or for some other appropriate reason
 - crew members of the vessel or similar persons whose voyage is related to their work (transfer crews).
- 2.3 A collection charge of **15.00 EUR** and a penal interest in accordance with the Finnish Interest Act will be charged for the collection of overdue payments.
