SHORE EXCURSIONS KOTKA ARCHIPELAGO BY TALL SHIP

Experience the beauty of the archipelago by sailing on board an old-fashioned tall ship, previously used to transport cargo around the Baltic Sea, now fitted out to provide a comfortable voyage for its guests.

A WALKING TOUR IN THE INTERNATIONALLY AWARDED LUSH PARKS

Join the walking tour of 5 km on the Kotka island and experience the beauty of the Park Capital of Finland. Dive into the historic, cultural and lush atmosphere from park to park and enjoy the scenery throughout the year.

THE SECRET GARDENS OF HAMINA

Go through the gates of old wooden houses, and meet the fascinating past of the fortress town Hamina with all its amazing historical characters. The owners of the houses and gardens are there to welcome you, and lunch and refreshments are available.

THE FINNISH SAUNA EXPERIENCE

Enjoy a thoroughly authentic Finnish experience by visiting a traditional smoke sauna at the seaside. This sauna is built inside a cave and is heated up with local wood, which provides soft, clean steam and a pleasant aroma.

YOGA BY THE SEA

Let the wind touch you. Let the sea give you its scent. Give your mind and body time to relax.

Breathe free and dive into your inner journey with soothing yoga by the sea in Katariina Seaside Park.

UNIQUE ATTRACTIONS LANGINKOSKI IMPERIAL FISHING LODGE

The Russian Emperor Alexander III visited the Kymijoki Delta at Langinkoski in the late 19th century when he was the Grand Duke of Finland. He was so enchanted by the natural beauty that he commissioned a fishing lodge to be built there. The lodge is now a museum surrounded by several waterways and a nature reserve.

VALKMUSA NATIONAL PARK

Valkmusa's extensive natural open bogs give visitors a chance to wind down and see, hear, smell and even taste nature all around. Look out for wetland birds and fluttering marshland butterflies, especially in spring and summer when the air is filled with birdsong. Find tasty cranberries growing among the bog moss. Hike along the 2.5 km marked circular trail with duckboards across the Valkmusa mires. On the way, climb the nature tower to observe the wide-open mire landscape and do some bird watching at the same time.

MARITIME CENTRE VELLAMO

Maritime Centre Vellamo is a multifunctional centre along the old quay which features two museums, The National Maritime Museum of Finland and Kymenlaakso Regional Museum, as well as a variety of temporary

exhibitions full of stories of the sea and the region. Vellamo is not an ordinary museum, as you can experience history in a variety of ways: listen, look, smell, touch and play.

THE AQUARIUM HOUSE MARETARIUM

Welcome to the underwater world of the Baltic Sea. You will meet over 60 different native species of fish and other water animals in the environment beneath the surface. The nature school "Haili" offers tailor made packages in environmental sustainability. Maretarium has received the Sustainable Travel Finland award in 2020.

UNIQUE EXPERIENCES COOKING CLASS IN THE FINNISH ARCHIPELAGO

When you step ashore, you will be met by the life of an old fishing village. The history of Kauhissaari begins with permanent settlement in the 16th century. Today, the island is a small summer village. In these surroundings, you will learn how to prepare and will enjoy a traditional archipelago dinner. The cooking class is conducted by an island resident, who specializes in making dishes from local ingredients. You can also choose to just relax and enjoy the beautiful island.

RAFTING

Discover the strength of Mother Nature in a safe and fun way at Kymijoki River! During the rafting trip, you will enjoy the idyllic nature sceneries of gorgeous Kymijoki River, the best rafting river

in Southern Finland. Experience the sensation of navigating the swirling rapids. After the rafting activities, relax by the campfire and enjoy the views of the picturesque rapids.

CATCH OF THE DAY

Experience fishing at the rapids of Siikakoski. The Kymijoki river is famous for being the best salmon river in Southern Finland. You can prepare your own catch-of-the-day by yourself, on open fire by the Siikakoski rapids. Or just enjoy a snack in the open air.

CULINARY EXPERIENCES CAMPFIRE PICNIC BY THE RAPIDS

After a trip along the Kymijoki river, you can enjoy a delicious campfire picnic of local food beside the free-flowing rapids.

TRADITIONAL PASTRY EXPERIENCE

You cannot visit Kotka without trying a posso, a traditional local pastry filled with apple jam, rolled in sugar and served warm. Enjoy your posso on a warm, sunny day in the Market Square while sipping coffee.

IDYLLIC LUNCHTIME

Enjoy salmon soup served warm and fresh in its place of origin. The Kalamaja café and restaurant is located by the sea in the nostalgic Kuusinen district at the tip of the island of Kotka. Here, you can catch a glimpse of the town's history as a fishing village.



The cruise port areas Kantasatama, Hamina and Mussalo are located nearby the city centres of Kotka island and Hamina, only 120 kilometres (90 minutes) from Helsinki along the E18 highway, 100 nautical miles from Tallinn and 125 nautical miles from St. Petersburg.
